### **Optional Choices:**

#### **Lunch**

5 Days a week. Students have a choice of two courses from homemade soup, a main course, a salad bar, a dessert or fruit. (Students may be requested to perform some light dining hall duties on a roster basis).

#### **Tea**

4 days a week at 5.30 pm. 5 days a week on open weekends. A main course or salad bar, sweet and fruit.

There are four options to choose from, each one includes an extensive study package which rises to as much as 28 hours per week over six days as well as supervised study over School holiday periods. While we feel it is important for the students to have a good study routine we would encourage the students to retain some level of sporting activity or join a School club. This helps maintain a good balance in the students' overall education for life. If senior cycle students are not engaged in the extra-curricular activities programme, we recommend they attend afternoon study. Evening Prep is compulsory for all day boarding students.
