## Optional Extras for Day Students

**Day Boarding:** Options include lunch, dinner, and evening study: the price is dependent on the number of options selected. The day starts for the day boarder at the normal time and finishes at 8.15 p.m. for Junior Cycle and 9.30 p.m. for the Senior Cycle. The cost of day boarding ranges from €600 to €1,860 per annum, depending on the option selected.

**Lunch:** €785 per year.

**Afternoon Study:** €65 annual fee per day (e.g. if your child signs up for study one day per week for the year the cost is €65, two days per week for the year the cost is €130, etc.)

**Supervised Study (at weekends and holidays):** €5 per day or €180 annual fee

## Payment Terms and Conditions

- i. A deposit is required, payable immediately on acceptance of an offer of a place in the School. The deposit is deducted from the annual fees. The deposit is non-refundable if the place is not taken:
  - The deposit required from Irish students is €500
  - The deposit required from all IBDP students is €2,500
- ii. Fees are expected to be paid in advance. There are three payment options:
  - In one payment due in August
  - In two semesterly payments due in August and December
  - In nine monthly payments to start in August and finish in April. This is available to Republic of Ireland residents only. An administration fee of €100 per year applies if paying in monthly instalments.
- iii. Fee accounts must be kept up to date in order to secure the student's place in the school from year to year. Breach of payment terms and conditions will result in the student's place being forfeited from the school and / or school activities.
- iv. School fees are inclusive of most extras including most sports and extra curricular activities. There is no extra charge for boarders for ordinary medical attendance and medicines but the fees do not cover prescriptions, tests, dentistry or taxis. Fortnightly boarding includes laundry.
- v. Optional extras will be itemised on the fee statement. Applications for optional extras, including extra curricular activities and trips away, will only be accepted if the fee account is up to date.
- vi. The school does not make allowance for:
  - Absence due to ill-health or otherwise
  - Absence or change of status due to any disciplinary action
  - Early Closure
  - Delayed Opening
  - Closures outside the control of the Board of Management and / or the Board of Governors
  - Force majeure
- vii. The signatory / ies on the student's entrance form is / are responsible for all monies due.
- viii. A semester's notice must be given, in writing, when a student is being withdrawn from the school. Should such notice not be received, one semester's fees will be charged in lieu of notice.
- ix. Interest will be charged on all overdue accounts. The current rate of interest is .022% per day.
- x. All details refer to cost for full academic year except where otherwise specified.
- xi. Fees are subject to review each year. The Board of Governors reserve the right to change the fees and charges.

## Grants/Bursaries/Discounts/Scholarships

**Grants:** The Secondary Education Committee gives means-tested grants to Irish resident children of Protestant parents, see [www.secgrant.ie](http://www.secgrant.ie) for further information. The amounts vary but can rise to €8,466 per annum for boarders and €3,174 per annum for day pupils.

**Bursaries:** The Governors' Bursary confirms the commitment of the Governors of Villiers School to uphold the initial wish of Mrs. Hannah Villiers to support the education of Protestant children. Applicants for this grant must be eligible to apply for an SEC boarding grant and the level of the Bursary will be dependent on this application. The maximum amount awarded for the 2022/2023 School year is projected at €934 per eligible student.

**Discounts:** A sibling discount of 10% is awarded to each child once there are two or more children from the same family in the School.

**Academic Scholarships:** Incoming Form I students are invited to attend our annual Scholarship Examination Day in May, prior to their commencement in Villiers. The exams are used to award scholarships to the top performers and also as a gauge to try to give equity to our new form groupings when the students commence school at the end of August. The Scholarship is tenable for the full six years, subject to satisfactory work and performance. The Scholarship is valued at €1,000 per annum.

There are four scholarships awarded:

- Top performing boarding girl
- Top performing boarding boy
- Top performing day girl
- Top performing day boy

**Hockey Scholarships:** Students selected to represent their Provincial Hockey team and / or the Irish Hockey Team may be awarded a Hockey scholarship in the academic year after representation:

- Day students who represent their Provincial Hockey Team may be awarded a scholarship of €500.
- Boarding students who represent their Provincial Hockey Team may be awarded a scholarship of €1,000.
- Day and Boarding students who also represent the Irish Hockey Team may be awarded an additional €500.

Hockey scholarships only apply to the academic year following representation.
